WORLD BOOK DAY

(Pre-Primary Grades)

General Guidance:

- Choose one activity per day from the activities given below as per your choice and convenience.
- Explain the importance of reading books to the children.
- Decorate the classroom with the World Book Day posters and display a variety of age-appropriate books for the children in the classroom.
- Children to come dressed up as their favourite storybook character for the activity **Story Book Character Parade**.

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Activity 1: Story Book Reading

- Read out simple yet interesting stories to the children form the story books.
- You may know the story but read the story word by word from the book.
- Pause at regular intervals and ask simple questions about the story or characters to check comprehension level and listening skills of the children.
- Encourage them to answer the questions.
- After completing the story, encourage the children to repeat the story narrated in the class.

Variation: You can also use rhyme books for this activity and recite rhymes for the book. Encourage the children to repeat after you.

Activity 2: Picture Book Reading


- Let the children sit in circle.
- Take a picture book and go through it page by page.
- Stop at every page and ask different questions related to the objects shown on that page.
- After that divide the children in pairs for this activity.
- Give a picture book to each pair and tell them to look at the pictures.
- Call the children one by one in front and encourage them to tell the names of the objects shown in the picture book. Give each child a chance to show few pages of the picture they have read.
- Guide the children whenever they need your help.


Variation: You can use story picture books for this activity and encourage the children to tell the stories form the picture books.


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












Activity 4: <u>Visit to a Book Store/</u> <u>School Library</u>

Prior Preparation:

- Make arrangements to visit a local book store with the children (optional) or you may take the children to the school library.
- Inform the parents well in advance about this activity.



Guidance:

- Take the children to a Book Store near the school/ school library.
- Show them the children's books section or the kids' corner.
- Encourage them to look through the picture books and story books that are ageappropriate.
- Have a short story-reading session at the book store/ school library.

Activity 5 - Story Book Character Parade

Prior Preparation:

- Inform the parents well in advance about this activity and ask them to arrange appropriate costumes and other accessories for the children.
- Also, ask the children to learn a line or two about the character, they are dressed up as.

Guidance:

- Ask the children to come dressed up as their favourite storybook character for the celebration.
- The children will come on the stage one by one and speak a line or two about the character.
- Applaud the children and appreciate their efforts.

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
